Article 1. This Regulation has been established in accordance with Article 20 of the University Act, Article 21 of the University's Organizational Rules, and the University's Regulations for the Establishment of Faculty Evaluation Committees (hereafter referred to as "the Committee").

Article 2. The Committee is responsible for reviewing the following matters:

1. Faculty-related matters, including appointment, terms, suspension, dismissal, non-renewal, extension of retirement, and reasons for termination of employment.
2. Faculty promotions and applications for appeal and review.
3. Faculty evaluations.
4. Decisions made by department (or institute) faculty evaluation committees regarding faculty suspension, dismissal, or non-renewal that clearly deviate from legal regulations or are evidently inappropriate, provided the evidence is substantial. The Committee may directly deliberate and amend such decisions as required.
5. Other matters mandated by law for review by the Committee

All decisions made by the Committee shall be submitted to the University's Faculty Evaluation Committee for review.

Article 3. The Committee shall comprise 7 to 9 professors. The dean is an ex officio member and serves as the convener and chairperson of meetings. Other members are elected by the College Affairs Meeting. As a general principle, each department should have at least one member and no more than three. Members serve a one-year term.

Article 4. A quorum of at least two-thirds of all members is required to convene a meeting. Decisions require the approval of at least two-thirds of attending members. Votes shall be cast anonymously. However, regarding the applicant's academic works or professional abilities, the Committee should respect expert evaluations and avoid making contradictory decisions via anonymous voting.

Ex officio members may delegate their duties to substitutes holding equivalent academic qualifications.

Members absent without valid reasons three times shall have their membership revoked.

If a member resigns or vacates their position, replacements shall follow the original appointment procedures outlined in these regulations.

Members directly involved in matters under review must recuse themselves.

Article 5. The Committee shall convene at least once per semester and may invite relevant personnel to attend as needed.

Article 6. Matters concerning faculty appointments, promotion evaluations, appeal review guidelines, faculty evaluations, and plagiarism handling shall be processed in

accordance with relevant laws and regulations.

Article 7. Full-time research personnel and professional technical staff engaged in teaching shall be governed by these regulations as applicable.

Article 8. These regulations shall take effect upon approval by the College Affairs Meeting and subsequent ratification by the University's Faculty Evaluation Committee.
